- Interdisciplinary River Week

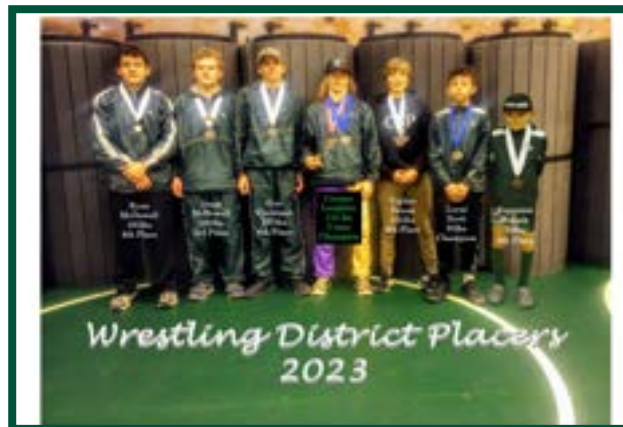


### Learning Through Inquiry
