Explanations and Definitions

- Students are to attend Teams classes just as they do normal classes when in the school building.
- Remote Learning is how we are doing school for Quarter 1. Attendance and Grades will be taken.
- I know the numbering system looks weird. It aligns with how we do things in a normal school year, but does not really make sense now because we have adapted to best fit a remote learning environment. We chose to not change the numbers because if we do return to in person learning at some time, that would make the transition more complicated because we would need to change the numbers back. Therefore, have your child simply follow the numbers in order through the day. Teachers will name their Teams classes to correlate with the numbers on their schedule.
- Classes will be conducted on Microsoft Teams. Students will make sure they can log in when they pick up their laptops on August 17th. We will send clear instructions on how to start on Teams their first day of school, and who to call if they are having complications.
- If a student misses class, they need to watch the recording of the class, check Google Classroom, and complete all work they can complete independently prior to contacting a teacher for assistance.
- If your child is routinely not able to attend Teams classes due to life circumstances, please contact your child's counselor to work on solutions and accommodations together.
- At the end of each class period, teachers will instruct students as to what they need to do in the afternoon.
- The Student Q & A time on Teams is time for any student to call a teacher on Teams to ask for assistance. This is also the time when teachers will be responding to email inquiries from students and parents.
- Teachers will assign independent work for Fridays. Plan for 30-45 minutes per class. The times on the schedule above are a guideline of how your child can organize his/her day. Teachers will also use this time to schedule small group time with select students as needed. When those are scheduled, parents will be informed.
- The 9-11am Virtual Office Hour time on Fridays is for students and/or parents to call teachers on Teams with questions, or for a parent to call a teacher on the phone to ask a question (more details about this to come later. This is a great time to ask a short logistical question about the class. This is also the time when teachers will be responding to email inquiries from students and parents.
- The 2-3pm individual meeting time on Fridays is time for you to schedule 10 minute meetings with a teacher if you have questions pertaining to your child.
- We do have a plan to begin ELO's, Advisory, and Olweus after Labor Day in the afternoons. We will communicate that change when it occurs.
